### THE GROVE ANNUAL REPORT AND GENERAL CHURCH MEETING

The General Church Meeting is to be held at 7.30pm on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2010 in the Main Hall of The Grove Centre. Whilst voting is restricted to church members, anyone associated with The Grove is welcome to attend to consider the future of the church. In addition to 4 vacancies, 1 representative, Gill Marley, is due to complete her term of appointment. Nominations for church members to serve on the Church Council for a 3 year period from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2010 should be given in writing to the Minister or Peter Mawson, Council Secretary, with names of proposer and seconder by Monday 26<sup>th</sup> April, as should items of any other business items for discussion will include The Grove's first Annual Report (copies available in the Narthex) and consequent suggestions for church priorities in the coming year.
